May this guide help raise a generation grounded in Scripture and committed to God's purpose.

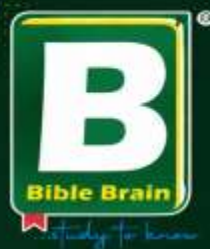

Examination Structure

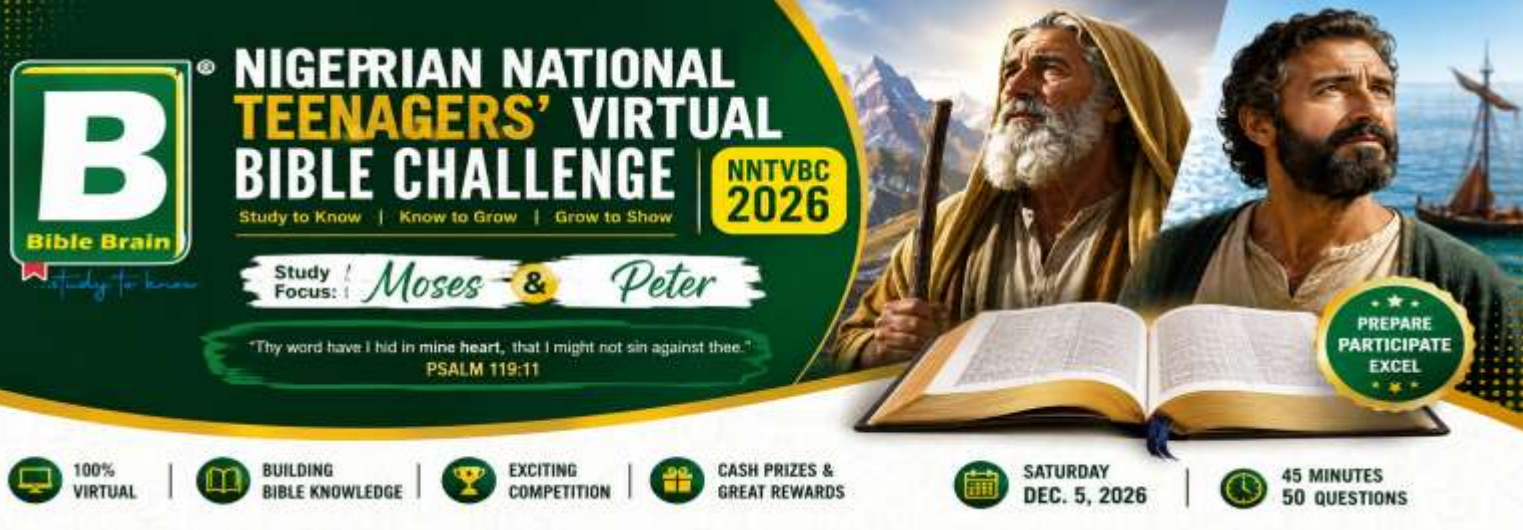

EXAMINATION COVERAGE

Questions will be drawn from:

- **Moses** – approximately 25 Questions
- **Peter** – approximately 25 Questions



Questions may assess:

- Events and timelines
- People and places
- Leadership principles
- Faith lessons
- Character development
- Application to Christian living

The life of Moses reminds us that God can use ordinary people to accomplish extraordinary purposes.



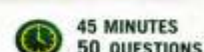
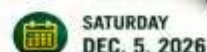
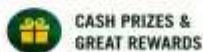
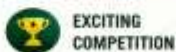
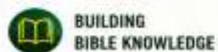

BIOGRAPHY

Peter was one of Jesus' closest disciples and one of the most influential leaders of the early Church.

Originally known as Simon, Peter worked as a fisherman before Jesus called him to become a "fisher of men." Peter was known for his boldness, enthusiasm, and willingness to act. Although he sometimes made mistakes, Jesus transformed him into a strong and effective leader.

After the resurrection of Jesus and the coming of the Holy Spirit, Peter became a powerful preacher whose ministry brought many people to faith in Christ.

His life demonstrates growth, restoration, courage, faith, and commitment to God's calling.
